EMERGENCY SUPPORT MEASURES



Direct supports for individuals and families Health care funding: \$500 million

Emergency Isolation Support:\$50 million (one-time payment of \$1146)

 Community and Social Services funding: (total \$60 million)

Adult homeless shelters: \$25 million

■ Women's emergency shelters: **\$5 million**

Community-based organizations: \$30 million

- Two month extension of driver's license, vehicle registration and ID card expiry date: up to \$60 million
- Freezing education property taxes saves households \$55 million
- Alberta student loan interest waived for six months:
 \$45 million
- Employment standards: 14-days of job-protected leave if directed to self-isolate
- Government is providing stability and security for Alberta renters



Supports to free up cash for individuals, families and Alberta businesses

- Alberta student loan deferral: \$148 million
- 90-day utility deferral program
- ATB Financial customer relief program: total loans to consumers and businesses that qualified for deferrals:
 \$3.6 billion to date
- Corporate income tax payment deferral to August 31, 2020, interest free: \$1.5 billion
- WCB premium payment deferral: \$750 million
- Six month education property tax deferral for businesses: \$458 million
- Two month extension of filing deadline for annual returns with Alberta Corporate Registry: up to \$6.3 million
- Deferral paying tourism levies for hotels and other lodging providers: Frees up more than \$5 million for employers
- Extensions for oil and gas tenures: extending the term of mineral agreements expiring in 2020 by one year



Direct supports for employers

- Freezing education property taxes saves businesses \$32 million
- Government to pay 50% WCB premiums for small and medium-sized businesses: \$350 million
- Government to pay Alberta Energy Regulator industry levy for six months: \$113 million
